## USAGE CHARGES AND POLICY FOR THE RADWINTER MUGA

## November 2022

Please see below the policy and hire charges for the MUGA. Apologies if it seems a little complicated, but there doesn't appear to be a simple way to do this.

The main objectives are:

- To keep the cost low for local people while at the same time generating income to go towards maintenance and renewals.
- 2. Accommodating people who want to play tennis while at the same time giving opportunities for the MUGA to be used for other sports.

Hopefully these arrangements will satisfy the majority but we may need to adjust this policy if it is not meeting the needs of the village. We also welcome feedback which can be emailed to the Management Committee at radwinter.recreation@gmail.com

## USAGE

The MUGA will be locked during school hours. During those times the courts and MUGA can be booked (access code will be given). When unlocked (evenings, weekends and school holidays) courts will be free of charge for all Radwinter residents and usage will be on a first come first served basis. No individual bookings can be made during this time.

## COST

Cost of hiring one court is £5.00 per hour.

Cost of hiring the whole MUGA is £10.00 per hour.

For Radwinter residents there will be an option to pay an annual fee for unlimited free bookings throughout the year. Bookings still need to be made during school hours as the MUGA will be locked.

£25.00 individual. £40 couple/family. Payment can be made by direct debit, bacs or cheque annually by direct debit. The year will run from the date of purchase. People who have paid the annual fee will be allowed to use the courts with visitors at no additional fee.
